Designate your school team of four students and your other registered individuals. No alternates please. If you have a registered team and registered individuals, be sure we know which students will compete as the school team and which are individuals. One group of 4 students will compete as the school team. The other registered individuals will compete as individuals. All students are eligible for state competition.

Students should bring their own calculators and pencils. Scratch paper and extra pencils will be provided.

School buses/vans can park in parking lots around the Student Union.

UNK will not reserve a Snow Date, so our policy is to have the competition on the scheduled date. If the weather is bad, use your best judgment about coming to the competition. If the weather is really bad (tough to define in Nebraska) we will try to reschedule the competition. We will send out an e-mail the day before the competition if the weather looks really bad. Target Round – 8 problems, presented in pairs; 6 minute time limit for each pair of problems, calculator allowed. Teams and individuals will take the test.

Sprint Round – 30 problems, 40 minutes to complete all of the problems, calculator not allowed. Teams and individuals will take the test

Team Round – 10 problems, 20 minutes to complete all problems. Calculators are allowed and the four team members can work together on the problems. Teams only will take the test. Individuals may be able to take the Team test but they will not be graded or used to calculate the Team scores.
